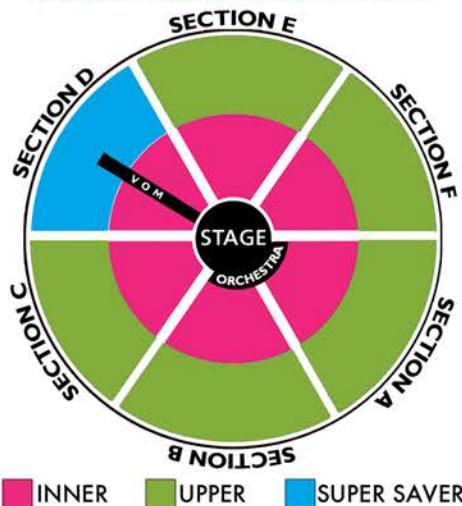




NSMT SEATING CHART

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

—
62 DUNHAM RD
BEVERLY, MA

FROM 128 SOUTH:

- Take exit 19.
- Turn right on Brimbal Ave, make immediate right onto Dunham Rd.
- North Shore Music Theatre is approximately 1/4 mile on the left.

FROM 128 NORTH:

- Turn right off Rt. 128 N at exit 19 to Sohier Rd/Brimbal Ave in Beverly.
- Stay left to enter rotary, take your second exit off rotary/roundabout.
- Stay left to enter a second rotary, take first exit off rotary/roundabout.
- Go over bridge.
- Pass the exit ramp to get on Rt. 128 S and take immediate right onto Dunham Rd.
- North Shore Music Theatre is approximately 1/4 mile on the left.

There's simply no better place to see a show than *in-the-round* at North Shore Music Theatre!

Since 1955, NSMT has become one of the most attended theatres in New England, with over 250,000 annual patrons. NSMT is a 1500-seat *theatre in the round* which has achieved both national and regional acclaim for artistic achievement.

NSMT produced the **World Premiere** of *Memphis* (2003) which went on to win four **Tony Awards** including Best Musical (2010). Under new ownership of Bill Hanney in 2010, we continue to produce our annual Broadway musical subscription series and award-winning production of *A Christmas Carol* – along with celebrity concerts, Shakespeare, children's shows, and year-round education for all ages.

YOUR FIELD TRIP EXPERIENCE AT NORTH SHORE MUSIC THEATRE

YOUR TRIP & ARRIVAL

Before your trip.

- Check to make sure your group is paid in full and your numbers are finalized.
- **Performance Study Guides** are available on our website under '**SHOWS > SCHOOL SHOWS**' and will be sent to group leaders approximately one (1) month prior to your performance.

Day of show.

- **Plan to arrive** at the theatre no later than one half hour (30 min) before your performance time.
- Groups arriving late will be seated at the discretion of NSMT's House Manager.

Upon arrival.

- **Please stay on the bus** until our greeter checks in with your group. Once cleared to enter, please stay together and enter thru your assigned door.
- If you're **traveling by car/van**, after parking, please go directly to the Box Office to receive your group's seating information.
- **No hats, gum, or outside food/drink** is allowed. This policy is strictly enforced. Please discard any of these items prior to entering.
- **Supervise your group at all times** and encourage them to respect our campus. Schools will be held responsible for damages.

ENJOY THE SHOW!

Lobby safety.

- **Concessions** may be open during some performances – only food/drink purchased from concessions are allowed in the theatre.
- **Restrooms** are located at both ends of the lobby – near the Box Office and Door 1 – and are to be used quietly, as a show may be going on.

Inside the theatre.

- Chaperones should be placed throughout your group to **monitor students at all times**. We ask chaperones to sit on the aisle for safety reasons.
- NSMT reserves the right to adjust seating as necessary. Please check with House Mgmt. staff for final seating information/map.

Once seated.

- Fire marshal protocol requires all patrons to remain seated until the house lights come on.
- **If you must exit** during the performance, an usher will assist you. When re-entering, an usher may ask you to wait a moment until it's safe to return to your seat.
- Talking, texting, and the use of cellular devices or smart watches during the performance is **strictly prohibited**. Disruptive patrons will be removed by House Mgmt. without a refund.
